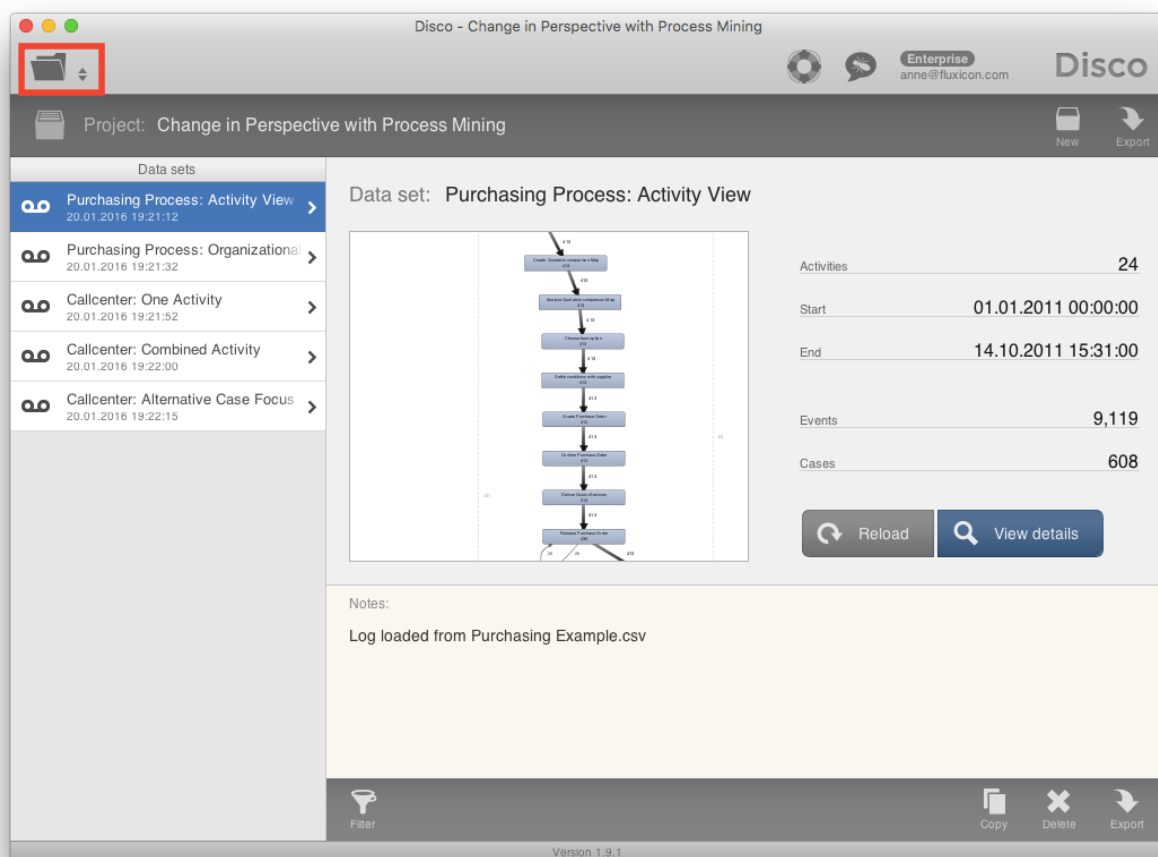


## How to Import the Example Files from the ‘Change in Perspectives’ Article

Do you want to explore the perspective changes presented in the KDNuggets<sup>1</sup> article <http://www.kdnuggets.com/2016/02/change-perspective-process-mining.html> in more detail for yourself?

Follow these steps:

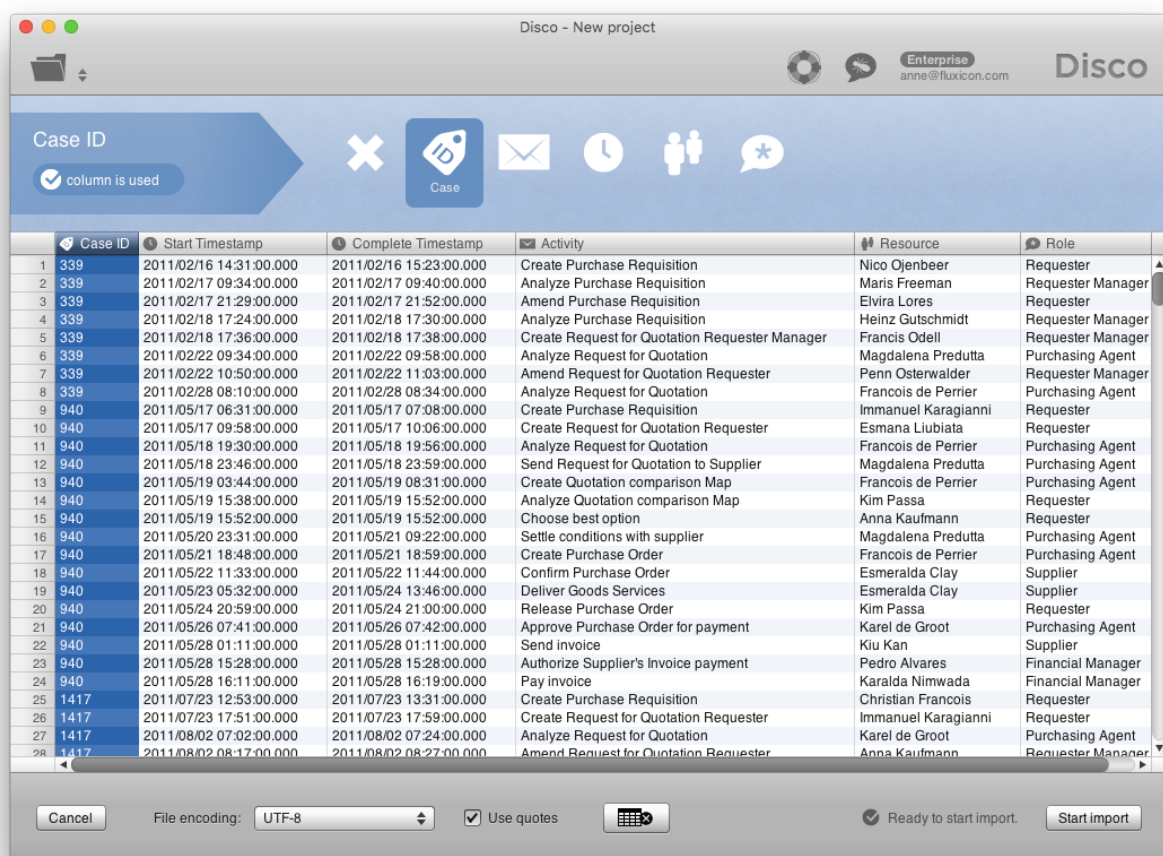
1. Download and install Disco from <http://fluxicon.com/disco/> (If you should run into the 'Cannot connect to the Internet' screen, press the 'Try again' button once and then follow the 'Use offline' instructions.)
2. Now press the 'Open' button and select the **Project-File-Disco.dsc** file. This will re-create the full workspace with the different import views explained in the article (see screenshot below).

3. However, to really explore these perspective changes, it is best to import some of the raw data from the **Example-Files/** folder. To do this, click on the open symbol in the upper left corner (see red rectangle above) and select one of the CSV files in that folder.

This will bring up the import screen (see below). Select each column (highlighted in blue) and choose the right configuration at the top. Then click 'Start import'. You will be automatically taken to the process map view!



Note that if you are working with the demo version of Disco, your file import is limited to 100 rows per file.
